During this fun, 3-Day art experience, you will expand your artistic skills in drawing, sketching on site, spatial observation and painting. Begin the journey with a field trip to the heart of colorful **Fremont** and **Gasworks Park** where we will practice urban sketching techniques in pencil and pen. Keep a field sketchbook and take photographs of subjects to incorporate into a painting back in the studio. Learn to structure a painting, mix colors and create your own interpretation of the "Seattle Scene." Have fun visiting sites and sketching architecture and sculpture in Fremont, including "Waiting for the Interurban" and "The Fremont Troll." Top off **Day 1** with a tour of famous "Theo's Chocolate!"
